# Driving Directions to USC Campus

Exposition Boulevard. At the end of the exit you will see the campus on the right-hand side one block down the street. Another convenient access is to exit from Santa Monica Freeway (I-10) on Vermont south to Jefferson Boulevard.



## USC BUS ROUTES

### North (Cardinal) Route:

**Sat 9am -6pm & Sun 9am - 5pm (Each loop: 15-20 minutes)**

### South (Gold) Route:

 Enter Gate #4 off Jefferson Blvd.

**N-17 USC Parking Structure 2 (PS2)**  
 Located at 3450 South Figueroa St.  
 Multiple Entrances - (1) Enter via the Radisson Hotel driveways 1 or 2.  
 (2) Enter through Exposition Blvd.  
 (3) Enter through Flower St.

**P-15 USC Parking Structure 1 (PS1)**  
Entrance 1 - Flower St. and Exposition Blvd.  
Entrance 2 - 37th Place and Flower St.

**NOT SHOWN** **USC Parking Center** (Bus Provided)  
Located just east of the 110 - Access to the Parking Center is on 35th St. and Grand Ave.
